

On Wednesday, Tiddler is thinking of a tall tale he can tell his teacher, can you think of your own tall tale Tiddler could tell his teacher.




Think about when Tiddler gets lost in the middle of the Ocean. Write a diary entry about how he might be feeling and what he might have seen.


Think about your favourite story you have read. Answer these questions...




