

### PE Days

Our allocated PE slots are Tuesday and Fridays. The children will also be participating in the 'Run a Mile' everyday challenge on the days they are not participating in PE sessions. These sessions will now be delivered outside so we advise that children have a pair of trainers left in school.

On PE days we ask that children arrive to school in their kit and remain in this all day.

Children will need to tie their hair up and remove any stud earrings or provide plasters. Hoop earrings are prohibited. It is important that you send your child with the appropriate PE kit, each session; we have a limited number of spare PE kits per class and no spare trainers. PE is a National Curriculum subject and your child needs to be given the opportunity to work with the PE coaches.

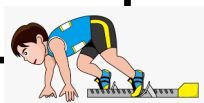

### Home—School Communication

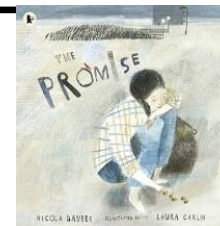
