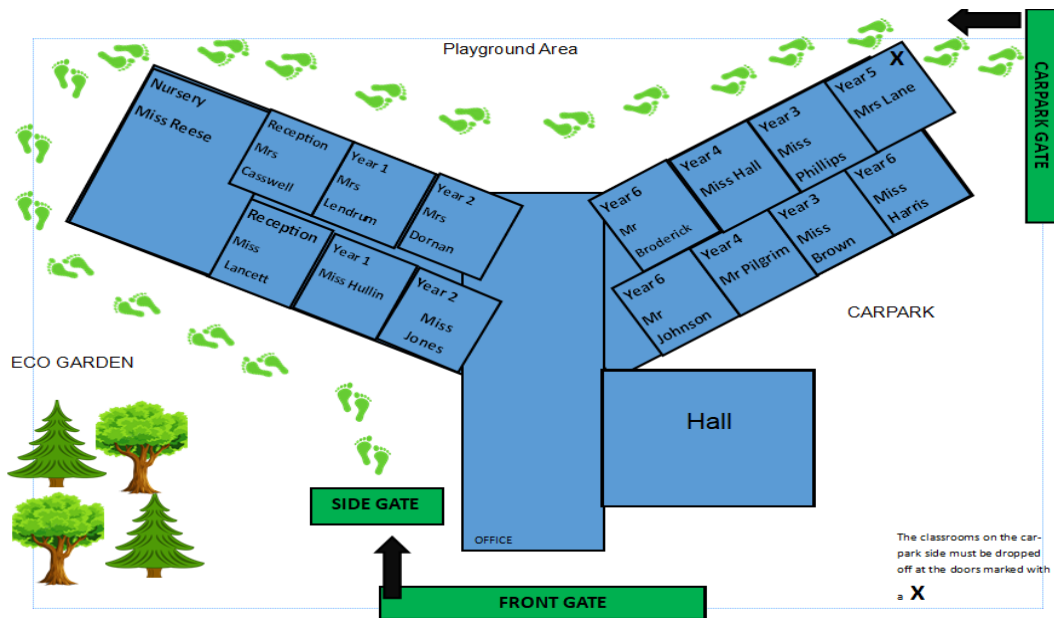
Dear all,

Keep ourselves and others safe by making sensible choices within school, online and when in the community.



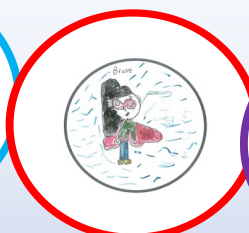
Respect
