Changes to the school day

Thank you all for taking the time to review the parent consultation and sending responses into school. We received 17 responses and out of these 15 were in support and 2 were not.

We will be changing the times of the school day to ensure that our children are receiving 32.5 hours of education a week.

The new timings are:

8.30am - doors open for children to enter classes

8.40am – doors close and the register is taken

Any child that arrives after **8.40am** will be recorded as late and any child that arrives after 9.10am will receive an unauthorised late code.

The classroom doors and gates will close at 8.40am and families will then need to enter via the main office.
