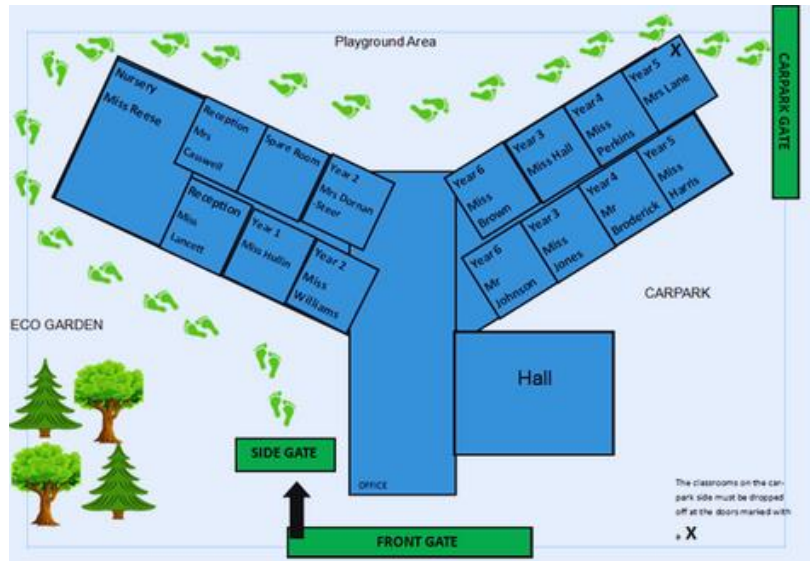

Swimming lessons for KS2

We have used our sports funding money for 2023-2024 to lease a pop-up swimming pool so that we can focus on teaching our children to swim.

We feel that this is a lifelong skill that could save a life and want to give our children the best start. The swimming pool comes with a fully trained swim coach for the 5 weeks that we have it.

All children in KS2 (Years 3-6) will need to bring swimming kits to school from Tuesday 5th September and they need to be in school everyday! Some children will have 2 lessons per week (see the poster attached for details).
