**Enrichment Wednesday**

In September 2021, we relaunched our after-school clubs and extra-curricular activities. Unfortunately, the uptake was low and the resilience of children to attend faded after a few weeks. We wanted ALL children to have the opportunity to access a range of activities that would enrich their lives and education at Sir Alexander Fleming.

So, in Spring 2022, we introduced Enrichment Wednesday! At 1:30pm ALL children from Year 2 to Year 6 come off timetable and move to their chosen activity until 2:45pm. All children participate and all adults participate. Our children need to develop their resilience and stick with an activity 1 club for the term.

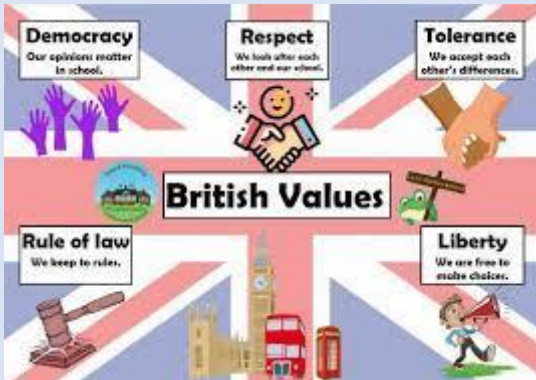
